This love manifests in several key areas

- Justice Striving for fairness equality and righting wrongs This includes advocating for the marginalized fighting for social justice and challenging systems that perpetuate inequality
- Compassion Showing empathy and mercy to those who are suffering providing practical help and emotional support
- Forgiveness Releasing resentment and bitterness choosing to extend grace to those who have wronged us This isnt condoning harmful actions but recognizing our own need for forgiveness and extending it to others
- Servanthood Putting others needs before our own humbly serving those around us

How to Apply the Kingdom in Your Daily Life This isnt a theoretical exercise its about tangible actions

Heres a practical guide

- 1 Prayer and Reflection Start your day with prayer seeking Gods guidance and asking for discernment Regular reflection on scripture will help you understand Gods character and His plan for your life
- 2 Cultivating Compassion Volunteer Dedicate time to a local charity or nonprofit organization Practice Active Listening Truly listen to others without interrupting or judging Offer practical help Assist neighbors friends or family members in need This could be anything from running errands to providing emotional support
- 3 Practicing Forgiveness Identify the resentment Acknowledge the hurt youve experienced and the emotions youre holding onto Pray for the person

heading people have a brighter future in eternity with their creator if they obey him and have faith in him for christians eternity with god is reached through faith in jesus christ his only begotten son and the perfect revelation of god the father to mankind john 3 16 14 6 10 god loves all people although he hates the bad things they do for he is holy he guides his people in righteousness and protects them he provides his people with air water food light soil minerals and vegetation for their existence and welfare truly there is no one like him god is invisible immortal omniscient omnipresent and omnipotent because of what he is mankind ought to worship him in the spirit and in truth for their salvation from sin and eternal death god has a salvation plan for mankind through jesus his son since we all fall short of his glory he is involved in the salvation history of mankind from birth to death the destinies of people are shaped by what they do upright attitudes and deeds through faith in jesus lead to eternal life whereas evil attitudes and behaviour lead to eternal death according to the salvific plan of god for mankind in john 3 19 21 john writes about god s verdict on human beings at the end of known time on judgement day this is the verdict light has come into the world but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil everyone who does evil hates the light and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed but whoever lives by the truth comes into the light so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of god the salvific plan of god for mankind is canonised in the holy bible for people to read and understand for their salvation god s plan starts at the fall of adam and eve or the first human beings and its climax is in the death and resurrection of jesus christ the lamb of god who died as an expiation for our sins john 3 16
