russia has never been able to escape its relationship with europe or europe with russia geography and history have conspired to make them both neighbors and unavoidable factors in each other s daily lives from the early 1700s until the collapse of the soviet union in 1991 europe and moscow both relied on material power to balance against any threats emerging from east and west more recently europe and the eu have adopted a different strategy make russia non threatening by making it european like us meanwhile russia s resistance to europe s assimilationist mission is increasingly robust fuelled by energy exports to europe and the world contributors to this volume wrestle with the question of whether the european project is feasible desirable or even ethical

a study of contemporary politics in russia assessing the attempted transition from totalitarianism to liberal democracy it shows that although

liberal institutions have been tentatively established the weak social and cultural supports threaten the success of russia s liberal project

this book analyzes the food revolution that has occurred in russia since the late 1980s documenting the transformation in systems of production supply distribution and consumption it examines the dominant actors in the food system explores how the state regulates food considers changes in patterns of food trade interactions with other states and discusses how all this and changing habits of consumption have impacted consumers it contrasts the grim food situation of 1980s and 1990s with the much better food situation that prevails at present and sets the food revolution in the context of the wider consumer revolution which has affected fashion consumer electronics and other sectors of the economy

sergei kovalyov is a central figure in the struggle for human rights in russia he was a leading soviet biology academic and in the 1970s after becoming active in dissident circles was arrested by the kgb tried imprisoned and subjected to internal exile after his release he continued to work for human rights eventually becoming chairman of the soviet human rights committee and chairman of the presidential human rights commission in which positions he was extremely influential in framing human rights provisions in post communist russia he subsequently took president yeltsin to task for human rights failings eventually resigning in protest this book by tracing kovalyov s political career shows how human rights developed in russia in late soviet and post soviet times

replacing family allowances with childcare subsidies in russia might have a strong positive effect on women s participation in the labor force and thus could be effective in reducing poverty

the putin and bush presidencies the 9 11 attack and the war in iraq have changed the dynamics of russian european us relations and strained the western alliance featuring contributions by leading experts in the field this work is the first systematic effort to reassess the status of russia s modernization efforts in this context part i examines political economic legal and cultural developments in russia for evidence of convergence with western norms in part ii the contributors systematically analyze russia s relations with the european union eastern europe central asia and the united states in light of new security concerns and changing economic and power relationships

sarah oates gives a detailed examination on a central theme in political science the relationship between democracy and the mass media this significant book contains a wealth of information and data including public opinion surveys content analysis of television news focus groups and in depth interviews to examine why political parties and the mass media failed so spectacularly to aid in the construction of a democratic system in russia the analysis presents compelling evidence that television helped to tune out democracy as it served as a tool for leaders rather than a conduit of information in the service of the electorate or parties in addition focus groups and surveys show that the russian audience are often more comfortable with authority rather than truth in television coverage within this framework this fascinating work presents the colourful history of parties elections and television during one of the most critical eras in russian history and captures a particularly significant epoch in contemporary russian politics

this work traces the attempt to complete the creation of a unified legal and political system in contemporary russia multiple political and legal aspects of the problem are examined by both political scientists and legal scholars the volume focuses on post soviet developments in russia especially during the putin administration the contributors perspectives include constitutional law judicial development law reform human rights federalism and international law the collective study finds that much progress has been made toward the unification of political and legal space in russia although significant problems remain to be addressed in order for the process to continue to move forward
